

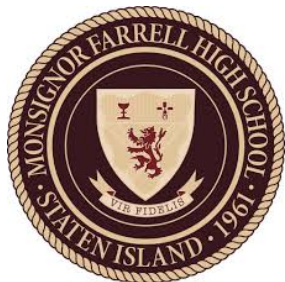
# UNITED STATES BOCCE FEDERATION QUARTERLY
